YOUR TUITION PAYMENT METHOD CAN HELP FAMILIES

CHECKS OR AUTO BANK DRAFT SAVE MINISTRY FUNDS

Credit cards and Pay Pal typically charge over 3% to process online payments. Last year, CRE paid over **\$10,000** in such fees. These funds instead could be used for tuition assistance for families in need, given a change in payment methods.

For this reason, CRE encourages parents to pay tuition invoices by either (1) mailing your checks or (2) setting up a bank auto draft (ACH).

Beginning January 2024, online tuition payments will contiinue to be accepted, with a 3% fee added to help cover a portion of the vendor convenience fees.
